Safety boats will be deployed in the vicinity to warn approaching crafts of the activity in the area.

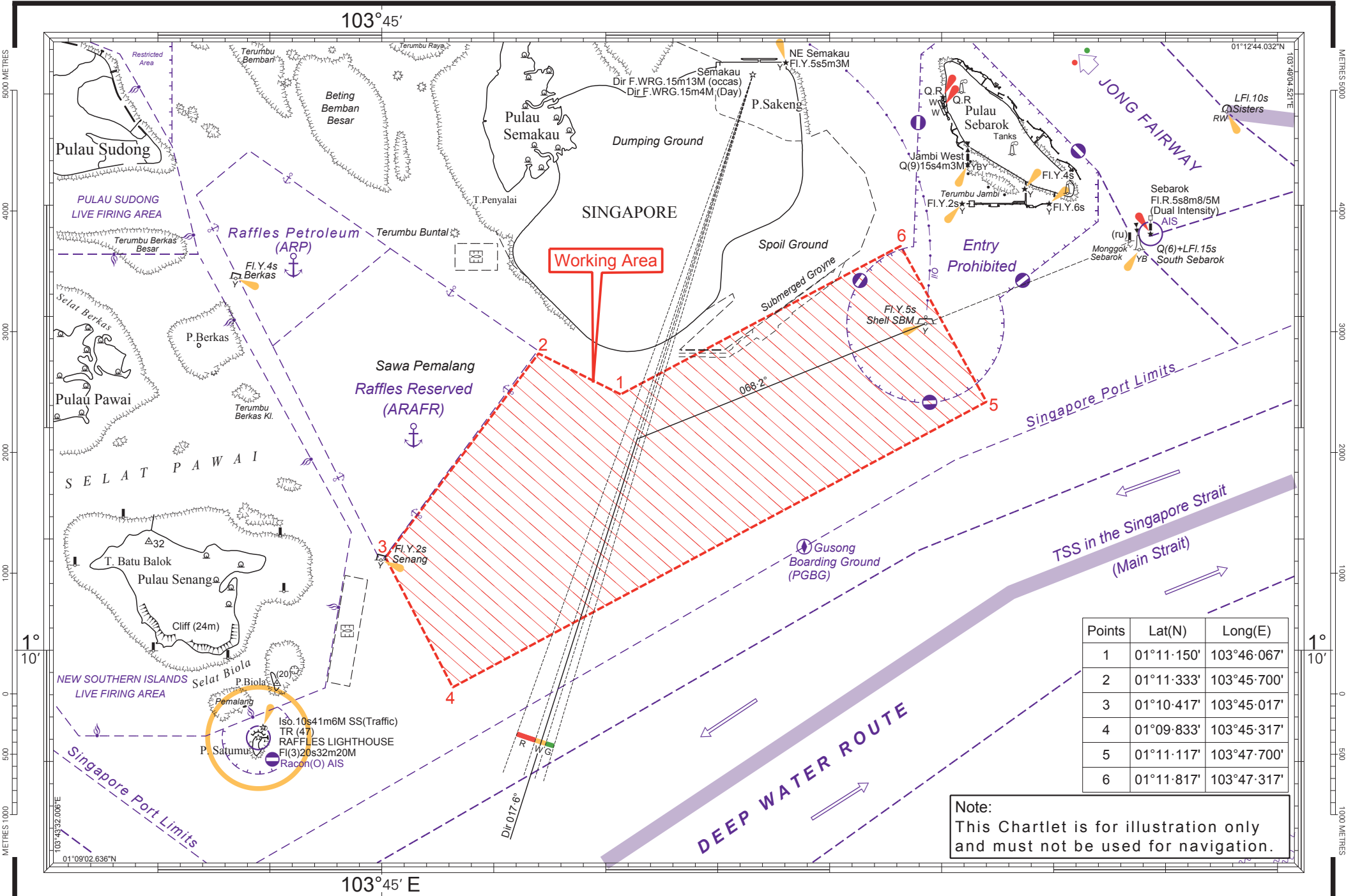
