These craft will exhibit the appropriate local and international day and night signals.

Details : Relocation of existing ferry piers and underpinning works in the working areas will be carried out using work barges assisted by tugboats.

All barges in the working area will require a safe working zone of 30 meters radius centered at the barge.

A safety boat will be in attendance at all times to warn and direct craft in the vicinity to keep clear of working area.

- 4) **Maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 05 (Cruise Bay Control); and**
- 5) **Communicate with VHF Channel 05 (Cruise Bay Control) for assistance if required.**

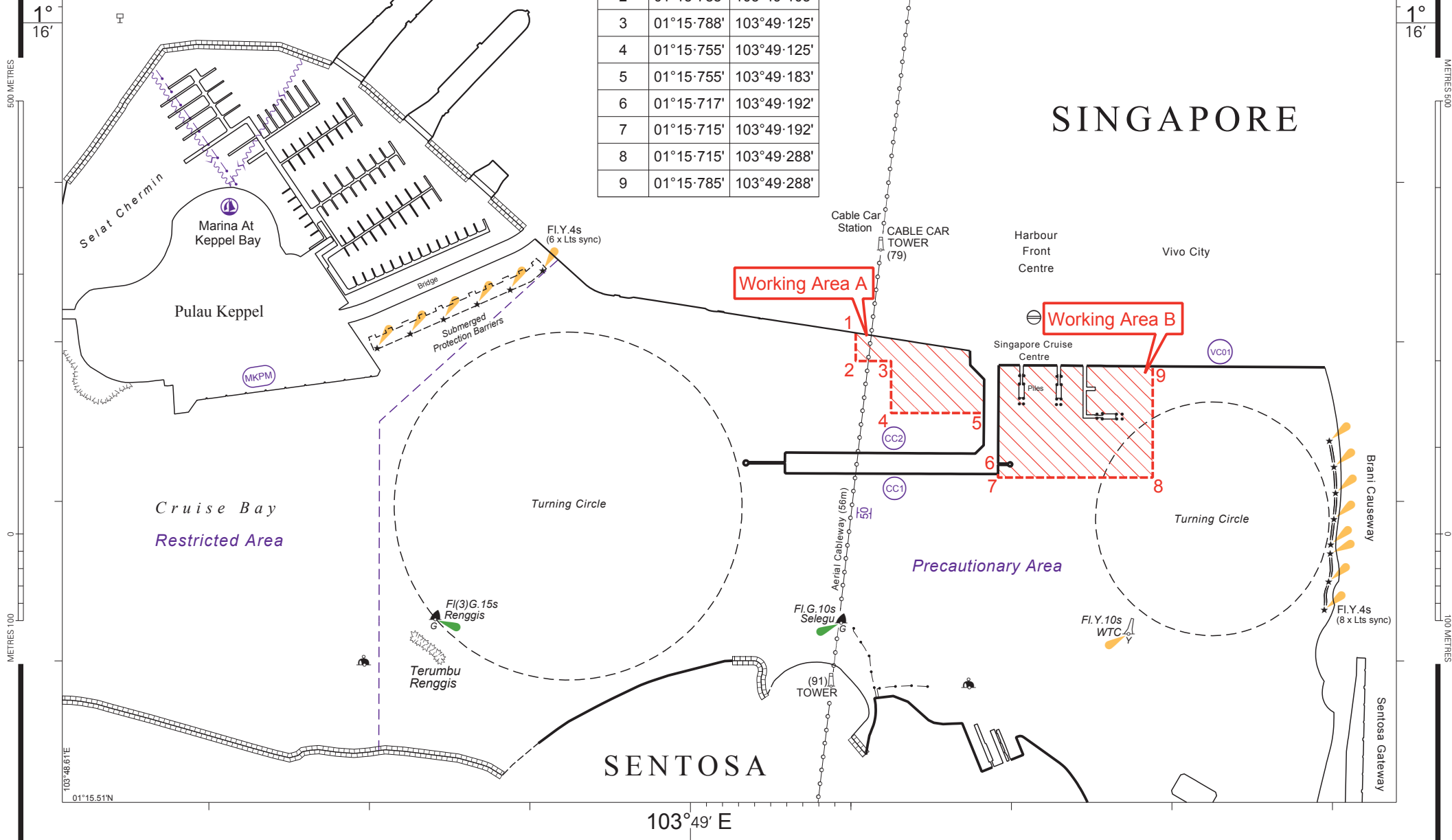
