#### **REVIEW OF PORT DUES**

- (A) CATEGORY 3 PORT DUES FOR VESSELS AT SHIPYARD
- (B) CATEGORY 4 PORT DUES FOR APPROVED OFFSHORE SUPPORT VESSELS
- (C) SALVAGE VESSELS 12-MONTH PORT DUES SCHEME

Reference is made to Port Marine Notice No. 47 of 2013.

#### (A) CATEGORY 3 PORT DUES FOR VESSELS AT SHIPYARD

- 2. With effect from 1 January 2014, a vessel that wishes to enjoy Category 3 port dues rates for the duration of its stay at a shipyard must:
  - (a) Make a declaration of Purpose Code 6 (Repair / Docking / Outfitting at Shipyard) in MPA's General Declaration Form; and
  - (b) Call at any of the MPA specified shipyards set out in **Annex A**.

## (B) CATEGORY 4 PORT DUES FOR APPROVED OFFSHORE SUPPORT VESSELS

- 3. With effect from 1 January 2014, Offshore Support Vessels approved by MPA are eligible to enjoy Category 4 port dues rates. To be considered for approval, an Offshore Support Vessel must meet any one of the following criteria:
  - have a Mobile Offshore Drilling Unit (MODU) Safety Certificate; or
  - have an Offshore Supply Vessel certification; or
  - have a Special Purpose Ship (SPS) Safety Certificate; or

- have an OSV (Offshore Supply Vessel) Notation or an Offshore Support Vessel Notation by Class on the Certificate of Classification acceptable to MPA; or
- has been hired to provide offshore support services for a minimum period of 4 months.
- 4. An Offshore Support Vessel that is approved by MPA will enjoy Category 4 port dues rates for any port call it makes:
  - (a) for the duration of its stay at any one of the following locations:
    - (i) the MPA specified offshore marine facilities set out in **Annex B**;
    - (ii) the MPA specified anchorages set out in **Annex C**, subject to availability of anchorage space,

provided,

- (b) it does not carry out any cargo operations during its stay at such location; and
- (c) it makes a declaration of Purpose Code 7 (Offshore Support Vessel without Cargo Operations) in MPA's General Declaration Form.
- 5. An application to be classified as an approved Offshore Support Vessel for the purposes of Category 4 port dues rates must be submitted by the owner, agent, master or person-in-charge of the Offshore Support Vessel in the form enclosed in **Annex D** together with all relevant supporting documents to:

#### (C) SALVAGE VESSELS 12-MONTH PORT DUES SCHEME

- 6. With effect from 1 January 2014, the current scheme under which Salvage Vessels moored at specified anchorages and private yards enjoy Category 3 port dues rates will be discontinued. Salvage Vessels that meet the criteria set out in paragraph 7 will be eligible to make payment of port dues under the Salvage Vessels 12-Month Port Dues Scheme.
- 7. A Salvage Vessel that wishes to make payment of port dues under the Salvage Vessels 12-Month Port Dues Scheme must:

- (a) ensure the Salvage Vessel is equipped with the required equipment for one or more of the purposes set out in **Annex E**; and
- (b) respond when activated to provide its assistance and services by the MPA, within 6 hours whilst such Salvage Vessel is in port, throughout the entire 12-month period for which it has made payment of port dues under the Salvage Vessels 12-Month Port Dues Scheme.
- 8. An application to pay port dues under the Salvage Vessels 12-Month Port Dues Scheme must be submitted by the owner, agent, master or person-in-charge of the Salvage Vessel in the form enclosed in **Annex F** to:
