

MARITIME AND PORT AUTHORITY OF SINGAPORE SHIPPING CIRCULAR NO. 15 OF 2022

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Applicable to: Shipowners, ship managers, operators, masters of Singapore-registered ships and other ships as applicable

REPORTING OF METEOROLOGICAL CONDITIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF AIDING NAVIGATION

- 1. This circular encourages ships when in the vicinity of a tropical cyclone, or of a suspected tropical cyclone, to take and transmit their observations at more frequent intervals whenever practicable, bearing in mind navigational preoccupations of ships' officers during storm conditions.
- 2. Ship masters are also encouraged to inform ships in the vicinity and also shore stations whenever they experience a wind speed of 50 knots or more (force 10 on the Beaufort scale).
- 3. The shipping community is encouraged to take note and report accordingly. More information on this matter, please refer to SOLAS Chapter V Regulation 5.2.
