**Applicable to:** This circular should be brought to the attention of Singapore's local seafarers as well as the shipping community.

### SAIL MILESTONE ACHIEVEMENT PROGRAMME (SailMAP)

As the lifeblood of the international shipping industry, Singapore recognises the importance of grooming interested individuals to pursue a long-term career in seafaring. To provide more support for our local seafarers, MPA, e2i, Singapore Shipping Association (SSA), Singapore Maritime Officers' Union (SMOU), and Singapore Organisation of Seamen (SOS) have launched the Sail Milestone Achievement Programme (SailMAP) to provide each local seafarer with up to S\$50,000 when they attain key milestones in their seafaring career. This programme aims to encourage local seafarers to sail to the highest level of competency (i.e. Certificate of Competency (COC) Class 1).

2 The details of SailMAP are as follows.

Eligibility	<ul> <li>Singapore Citizen or Singapore Permanent Resident who possesses a Singapore-issued COC and has graduated from any one of the following courses:</li> <li>Diploma in Nautical Studies (DNS) from Singapore Maritime Academy (SMA)</li> <li>Diploma in Marine Engineering (DMR) from SMA</li> <li>Tripartite Nautical Training Award (TNTA) from Wavelink Maritime Institute (WMI)</li> <li>Tripartite Engineering Training Award (TETA) from WMI</li> <li>Scholars under the Tripartite Maritime Scholarship (TMSS) are not eligible for SailMAP.</li> </ul>	
Incentives	a) Waiver of COC 3/5 <sup>1</sup> MPA examination fee for <u>first attempt only</u>

	<ul> <li>d) Attend COC 2/1 preparatory course conducted by SMA: \$\$1,000 monthly allowance (capped at 6 months)</li> </ul>		
	e) Attain COC 2 <sup>5</sup> : <b>\$\$4,000</b>		
	f) Sign on first ocean-going ship <sup>6</sup> while holding valid COC 2: <b>S\$5,000</b>		
	<ul> <li>g) Clock required qualifying sea-going service while holding valid COC</li> <li>2 and obtain Letter of Eligibility for COC Class 1 MPA examination:</li> </ul>		
	S\$10,000		
	h) Attain COC 1 <sup>5</sup> : <b>S\$5,000</b>

Application	Application commences on <b>1 June 2022</b> .		
	Applicants must <u>commence</u> each milestone on/after 1 June 2022 to be eligible for the corresponding incentive.

	Kindly note that you are not eligible to receive incentives that are not		
	relevant to your current status. For example, if you are sailing on your		
	second ship as a COC 3/5 holder, you will not be eligible for the		
	incentive "b) Sign on first ocean-going ship while holding valid COC		
	3/5" but can still enjoy the subsequent benefits.


