Details of the Awards

(1) Outstanding Contribution to Search and Rescue Efforts in 2021

Award Criteria

Successful and high-profile search and rescue (SAR) operations as defined by SOLAS Chapter V, Regulation 33

- Involving an SRS or an SG company
- For vessel in SG maritime search and rescue region/port water

Award Evaluation

Voluntary SAR involving an SRS or an SG company on the high seas must:

- Consider the challenges during SAR operation including inclement weather faced
- Demonstrate substantial diversion or time taken for the SAR

Voluntary SAR involving vessel in SG Maritime SRR / port water must:

- Consider the challenges during SAR operation including inclement weather faced
- Distance to nearest coastline with available assistance

(2) Outstanding Contribution to Safety at Sea (Individual)

Award Criteria

Individuals who consistently and substantially demonstrate:

- Criteria A*:
Safety in working environment and in engagement with the maritime industry.
- Criteria B*:
Active voluntary contribution & participation in safety at sea initiatives, such as community or ground up initiatives for education and outreach. Providing leadership or setting a personal example in promoting a safety at sea culture.

Award Evaluation

Outstanding work done by the nominee must either be:

- Recognised by MPA, NMSSC or NMSSC's safety work groups; or

- Recognised by reputable publications or agencies

(3) Outstanding Contribution to Safety at Sea (Corporate)

Award Criteria

Organisations who consistently and substantially demonstrate:

- For Owners/ Operators of Ocean-Going Vessels:
 - Safety throughout fleet/organisation
 - Low incident rates
 - High safety score
 - International/ local accreditation for safety of operations
- For all Harbour Craft within Singapore waters, MPA-licensed Pleasure Craft under the Singapore Registry of Ships and Regional Ferry Service Operators:
 - Active voluntary contribution & participation in safety at sea initiatives (e.g., community / ground up initiatives for education and outreach)
 - Providing leadership or setting a personal example in promoting a safety at sea culture

Award Evaluation

For Owners/ Operators of Ocean-Going Vessels:

- Outstanding work done by organisations must:
 - Receive international accolades and recognition by international maritime stakeholders/ organisations.
 - Demonstrate favourable Port State Control records over a three-year period (e.g., observation per inspection, detention records)
 - Show improvement in safety KPIs over a three-year period (e.g., Fatality, LTIF, TRCF etc.).

For all Harbour Craft within Singapore waters, including MPA-licensed Pleasure Craft under the Singapore Registry of Ships and Regional Ferry Service Operators:

- Outstanding work done by organisations must be recognised by MPA, NMSSC, NMSSC's safety work groups, or recognised by reputable publications or agencies

(4) Open Category

Award Criteria

- Innovation in technology/ systems and design/ training demonstrating safety at sea within the maritime industry
- Reporting Culture

Award Evaluation

Innovation in technology or systems, and design or training must demonstrate that the innovation or training can substantially improve safety at sea or has been in use by shipping organisations or offshore facilities.

For Reporting Culture, there must be a submission of high quality near misses and incidents reporting to MPA.
