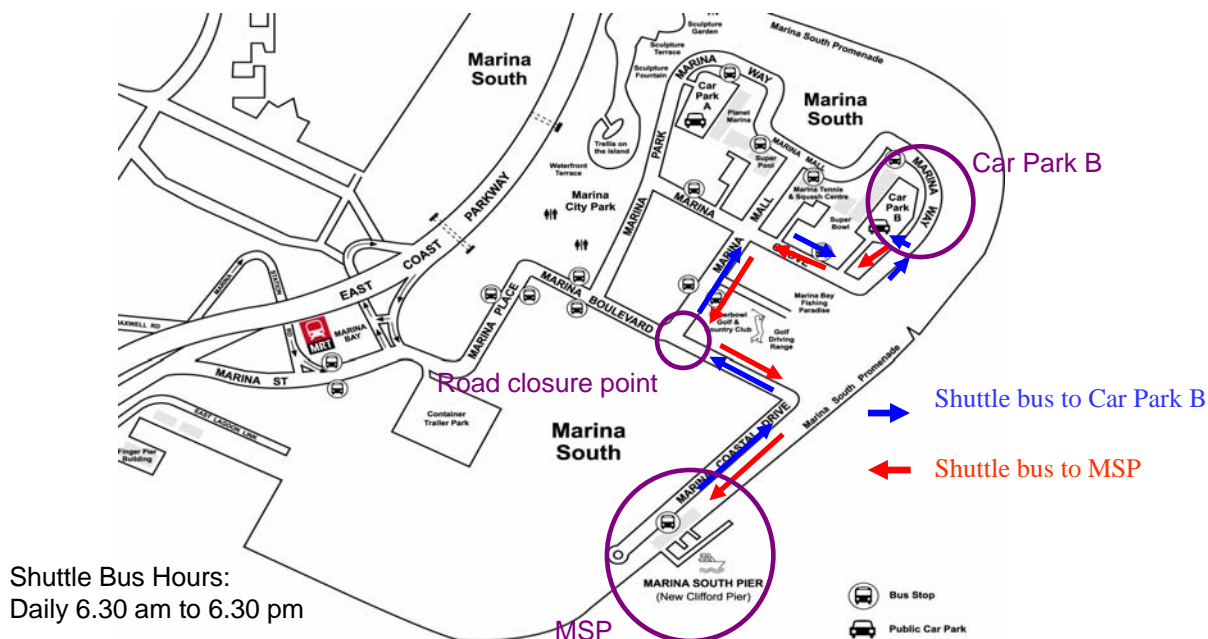


Kusu Pilgrimage Season (22 Oct - 20 Nov)

Getting to Marina South Pier (MSP)



In view of the anticipated large crowds and heavy traffic during the Kusu Pilgrimage season, the public is strongly advised to use public transport to get to MSP and to visit Kusu Island during the weekdays and off-peak times where possible. The public is also encouraged to purchase their ferry tickets in advance. Please note that Marina Coastal Drive will be closed to traffic (except authorised vehicles) on weekends and public holidays, from 6am to 3pm, during the pilgrimage season between 22 Oct and 20 Nov. If Driving:

Please park at Car Park B. A free shuttle service will be provided between Car Park B and MSP.

By Public Transport:

Bus: SBS Transit Bus Service 402 is a loop service running between MSP and Apex Tower. Public can take the service from Shenton Way (opposite MAS Building) or Anson Road (Apex Tower). The frequency of this service will be increased during the Kusu Pilgrimage season.

MRT: Alight at Marina Bay Station (NS27). Use Exit A and transfer to SBS Transit Service 402 at the bus stop outside the station.

Taxi: During the road closures, taxis will not be allowed to enter Marina Coastal Drive. At other times, taxis will be allowed to pick-up/drop off passengers at MSP, but will not be allowed to wait.

Free Shuttle Bus Service

The Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA) will provide a free shuttle bus service between Car Park B and MSP during the Kusu Pilgrimage season.

Weekdays:

At 15-minute intervals between 6.30am and 6.30 pm

Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays:

At 10-minute intervals between 6.30am and 2.00pm; and

At 15-minute intervals between 2.00pm and 6.30pm
