Marine Soil Investigation Works for Jetty Construction at Changi East

Applicable to: Mariners operating in the vicinity of Changi East.

Date : With effect from 02 Mar 2024 to 31 Jul 2024.

Location : Total 4 borehole locations with the following co-ordinates (see attached chartlet) in the vicinity of Changi East:

These craft will exhibit the appropriate local and international day and night signals.

Details : Soil investigation work will be carried out by means of sinking boreholes. Drilling will be carried out by the jack-up platform, held in position by 4 jack-up legs. The platform will have a circular safety working zone of 30 meters radius centered from the platform.

Two tugboats will be used for shifting the platform from one bore hole to another.

A safety boat will be in attendance at all times to warn and direct craft in the vicinity to keep clear of working area.
